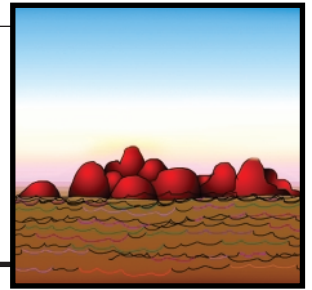

- include short biographical information for the introduction to your workshop

AUDIO VISUAL REQUIREMENTS:

- whiteboard, overhead projector, video player/ monitor, data projector (it is preferable that data show projectors and laptops be provided by presenters to minimise risk of incompatibility or malfunction.)

The conference committee will select sessions with a view to convening an interesting and balanced program. Presenters will be contacted by the conference organisers to confirm details of the presentation by 31 March 2003
