*'Learning Across the Lifespan: Children and Adults  
Engage with Digital Media'*

This talk will outline an outreach program that links the University of California (Berkeley) with local community organisations, faith-based institutions and schools in neglected neighbourhoods and urban centres, for access to digital technologies. This project not only challenges US federal policies on child and adult education but also assists in empowering personal and vocational uses via community-based technology centres. Taking a broad view of human development that foregrounds the centrality of symbolic creativity and identity construction across the age range, consideration will be given to purposes for literacy that go beyond the instrumental and to educational spaces that are inclusive of various axes of difference. It will be argued that the need has never been greater to explore alternative definitions of and means for facilitating growth and change across the lifespan.
